## ***SOME GLIMPSES OF MARWARI COLLEGE, RANCHI***

Marwari College, Ranchi, was established in 1963 by the Marwari Shiksha Trust. The college took a start by holding classes in the local Marwari School near Shahid Chowk, marred by several constraints at its inception in July 1963. In its initial stage only evening classes were arranged keeping in view that working people would get an opportunity to learn at the college level if they needed to do so, In the beginning only Commerce and Arts subjects were introduced in 1963 and only 30 students were enrolled in Pre University, 64 students in B.A, 76 in B.Com. After the initial teaching troubles, Marwari College soon become a centre of higher education for girls also when in July 1967 a separate girls' wing was opened in the morning and 550 girl students were admitted.

But by 1975 a magnificent three storied college building with a playground was built with UGC financial assistance under the guidance of Late Ganga Prasad Budhia, the founder President and later the Secretary of the Governing Body in a 5 acre area. In this building two sessions were started, a morning session for Commerce students and a day session for Arts & Science. In 1977-1978 Intermediate Science, and in 1980 Science at degree level was started. Now, Marwari College Ranchi, has become a full fledged higher educational institution in the heart of Ranchi, now the capital of Jharkhand. The devotion, dedication and unbeatable zeal of the Marwari College teaching, nonteaching and administrative staff the attention of the Ranchi University authorities so much that the name of Marwari College Ranchi, was forwarded and recommended for making it a constituent unit to the Govt. of Bihar in 1979. Consequently, Marwari College, Ranchi was honored with constituent status under Ranchi University, Ranchi, in 1980. An exclusive wing for girl students "Marwari College Women's Section" was established in old Ranchi University Campus near Telephone Exchange, Ranchi, with the approval of Ranchi University Ranchi.

At present, Marwari College, Ranchi has the largest number of students not only in Jharkhand but also in undivided Bihar and most other states of the country. The college now has a total of 16,398 students on its rolls.

### **FACILITIES :**

Apart from the graduate courses in almost all subjects, the college now offers P.G. teaching in Commerce. This was started in 1997. At the Intermediate and Graduation level this college imparts education in all the three Faculties - Science, Arts and Commerce with Honours.

Besides the traditional courses run in the universities, Marwari College, Ranchi has

many professional courses approved by the University Grants Commission. Professional courses like Biotechnology, Computer Application and Computer Maintenance, Information Technology and Fashion Designing are prestigious departments of this college with adequate laboratory and library facilities. Indira Gandhi National Open University has accorded the status of accredited study centre in the year 1995. To the credit of its management and staff of this college, this IGNOU study center has largest number of students in the region with the maximum number of courses available for one single center. This is the only College in the Country where two IGNOU Centres are running creditably.

Marwari College, Ranchi does not only have the maximum number of students but about 1,00,300 books are available in its library for which the present space is inadequate. A separate UGC aided library building is newly built which is computerized & has on-line facilities in its reading room. For the overall developments of its students this college offers all facilities in Sports, NSS and NCC. Debates, Seminars, Quiz, educational tours, youth festivals etc. are regularly organized. A wing of Sahitya Parishad Organizes competitions in Essay Writing, poetry, debate and quiz for both Boy's and Women's Sections.

Behind all the above briefly mentioned facilities in Marwari College, Ranchi, there is a team of 90 members of the teaching staff out of which, 59 are Ph.D. Degree holders and 03 D.Litt's. There are about 105 members of the nonteaching staff who have nourished this institution with pious zeal and vigorous enthusiasm right from its infancy to a great educational institution with a devoted team leader, its Principal.

The present status of the college is in itself a testimony to its achievements. In the academic field, the average 'Pass Percentage' of the students of this college is about 78 % at all levels in both Boys' and Women's Sections. It is worth mentioning here that this college has earned a great reputation in Commerce teaching due to which the Ranchi University has honoured this institution with P.G. Teaching in Commerce. The students of this college have brought this institution into the limelight in the arena of different competitive examinations and have placed themselves in prestigious positions. Not only in traditional courses, but also in other specialised courses such as Biotechnology Students, have secured admissions in institutions of national repute and have qualified for jobs available for this stream of vocational courses. Students of C.A. Foundation and IGNOU have achieved remarkable success in different sectors.

Apart from academics, in Sports, NCC and NSS, the Boy and Girl students have participated in state and national levels. Besides, the college has hosted state & national level events in sports like Cricket, Volleyball, Badminton, Football, Kabadi, Wrestling, Athletics etc. with awards. The NCC cadets both Boys and Girls have participated in the Republic

Day parade on many occasions. Besides sports and NCC, Marwari College, has two units of NSS for Boys' and Women's Sections and the volunteers have participated and organized camps, Tree Plantation and Environment Awareness Programmes etc., for the national cause.

## **CULTURE & ARTS :**

Marwari College has always had a healthy tradition of cultural activities ranging from music and the fine arts to Theatre and Dramatics. The college is fortunate in having among its faculty such versatile and talented persons as Dr. A.K. Malkani an alumni of National School of Drama and Prof. Kumar A.N. Shahdeo who guide and train students in various activities. The College is an enthusiastic participant in all youth festivals held in the state across the country.
